Gloria’s love of art began when, as a small
child, she spent endless hours on her
stomach coloring, drawing & cutting out
paper designs. She continued her artwork in
school & received an art scholarship to
college. However, her greater desire to
minister to others led her to give up art for
nursing. She quit school to marry & raise
children, but when all three children were in
school, she returned to college to finish her
degree & obtained a Master’s degree in
Counseling. A successful career in mental
health therapy & as a youth-in-crisis program
manager was ultimately cut short by
debilitating arthritis.



Over the years
she had kept
an interest in
art dabbling in

wood carving & beaded jewelry. No longer able
to continue full-time employment, she turned to
jewelry making for therapy & entertainment.

Her colorful & tasteful creations were so well
received by friends & family, she began selling
