Larry Harvey has lived in Albuquerque for over 40 years and has been involved in Southwestern ceramics for over two decades. Producing greenware and bisque for local artists, Larry is a sculptor, who works with ceramic designs that can be either proprietary or public.



Larry designs his pieces and his work process involves his son and friends of his, working together to create each piece, giving the pieces that touch of family & community. The Pueblo, Mission, and TP ornaments were designs made by Larry and then the molds were made by his son Bart. The molds are poured by Larry and each piece is allowed to mature until it is strong enough for the windows and doors to be hand cut. The piece is then cleaned and fired to approximately 1960 degrees, the temperature may vary if a different color is needed for the bisque piece.
